#### FLU-12 Student Fluency Graphs

Students make graphs of fluency results. MATERIALS: Graph paper, pencils/markers

• Teach and model graphing of fluency for the whole class. On the vertical axis, show the number of words read correctly in a minute. On the horizontal axis, list the title of each reading and the date it was read. Draw a bar for each reading that shows the words correct per minute (WCPM) score for the reading.

2 Students practice making graphs with your feedback.

Students write the date and name of the story on the graph.

4 Students graph fluency results from their reading.

Students compare their own fluency scores across stories.

**NOTE:** It is NOT recommended that students chart WCPM for other students. Consider this an individual activity.



**PREPARATION OF MATERIALS:** Print the appropriate Student Fluency Graph. Provide each student a fluency graph and pencil. Follow the directions for the activity.

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
