



Phonemic Awareness Phoneme Play: Phoneme Segmentation PA-67 Move the Sounds		
As you say a word, students move a chip for each of its sounds. MATERIALS: Chips/counters		
 Provide each student with three or four chips. Say a word. Ask students to move a chip for each sound they hear in the word. 	 Switch between two or more sounds to vary the number of phonemes students provide. NOTE: Remember, this is an auditory activity. Don't write the words. 	
 VARIATION: MATERIALS: Word list, paper, chips/counters, marker Draw a row of four squares on paper. Provide each student a copy and three or four chips. 2 Say a word. 3 Ask students to repeat the word. 	Blackline Master available www.tpri.org Students then say each phoneme in the word separately while moving a chip into a box. Start with two- and three-phoneme words, then mix in words with up to four sounds.
