VOC-21 Mapping Multiple-Meaning Words

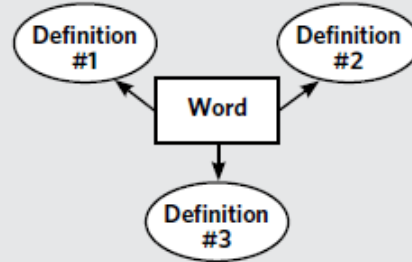

- 4 Create a sample sentence to go with each definition.

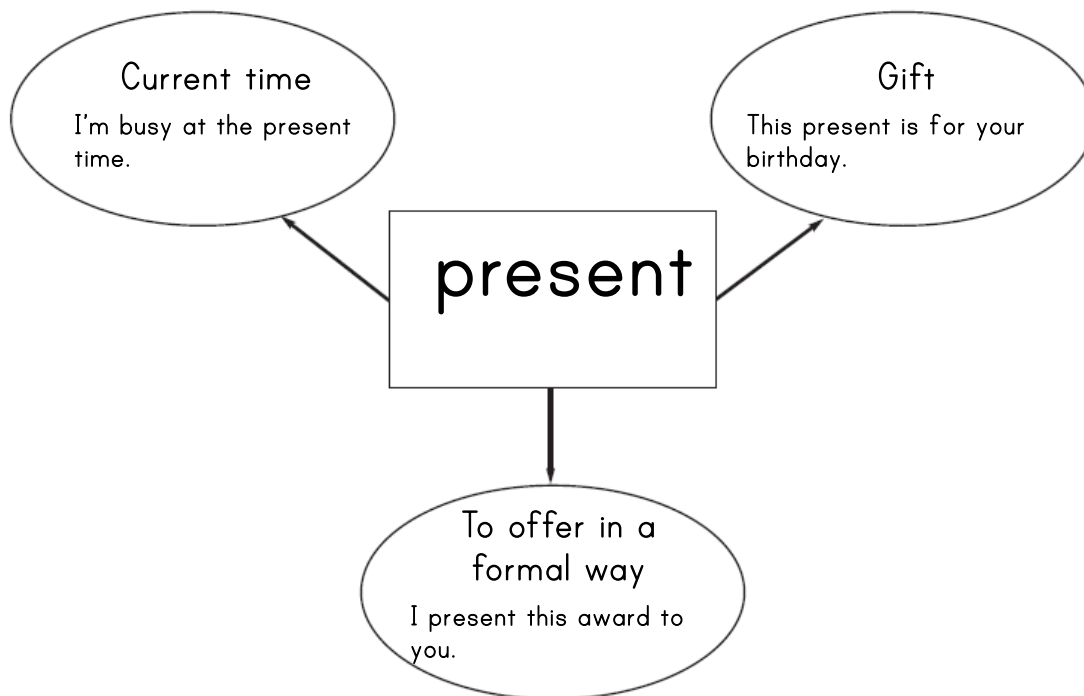

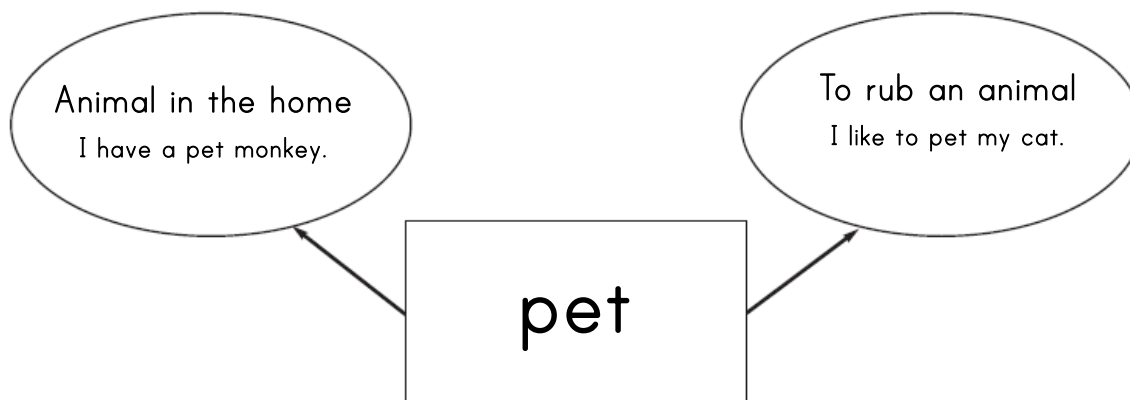

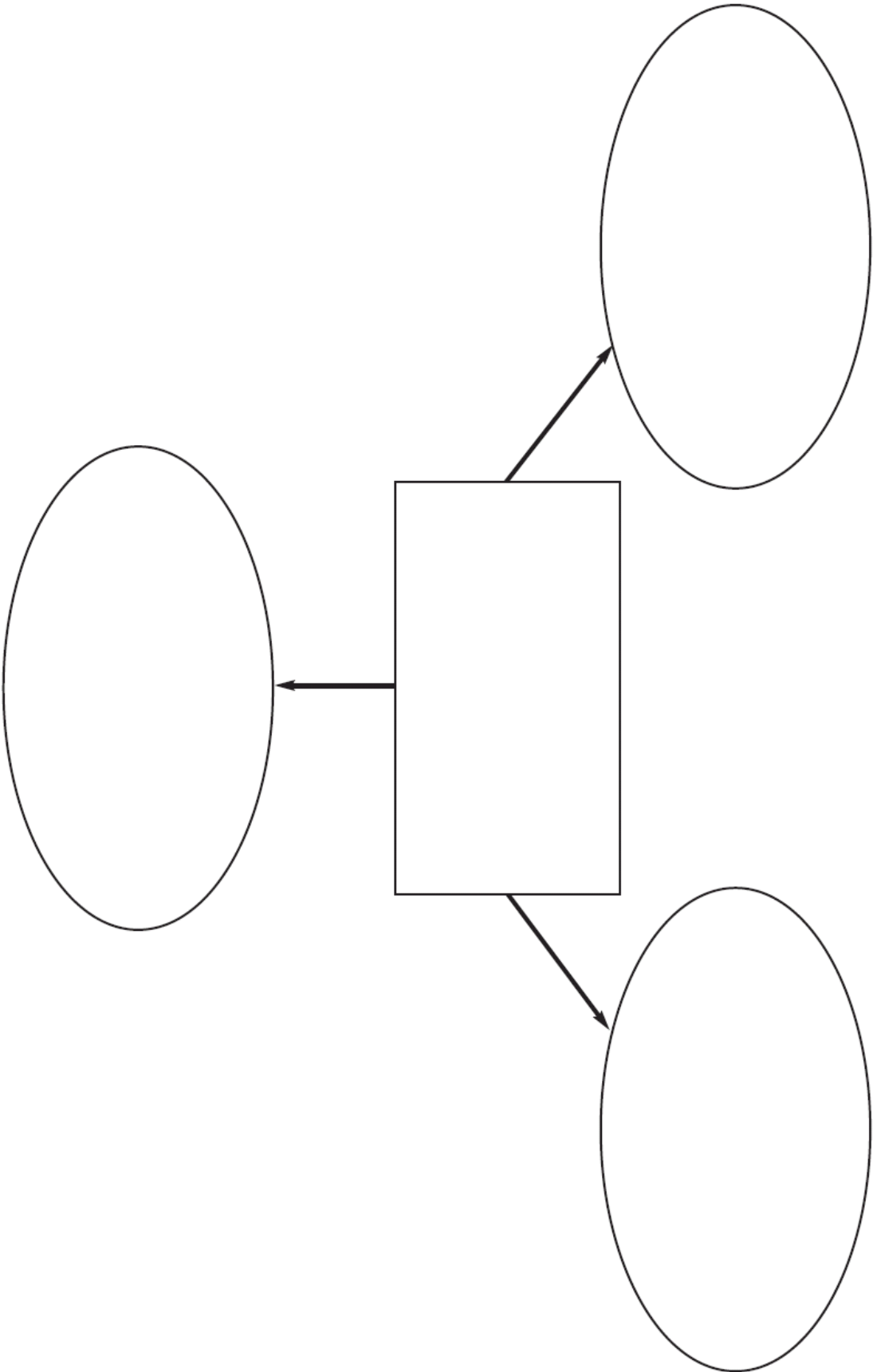
