Offer Prompts for Peer Interaction

During the Offer Prompts for Peer Interaction I2 video, the teacher uses narration to help the babies pay attention to and interact with each other. She points out their actions ("Look at your friend standing there") and encourages them to "talk" to each other ("Say 'Hi, Baron.'"). The teacher also praises their actions and encourages them to clap and stand together.

Practice applying the key concepts demonstrated in this activity on your own by:

- · drawing attention to another child's friendly actions
- · consistently using children's names when narrating
