CLASSROOM ELIGIBILITY 2023–2025

CHILD CARE PROGRAMS

All child care programs must be in good standing with Child Care Regulation and have at least 12 months of licensing history. Programs must be serving at least 50% at-risk children meeting Eligibility Requirements for State-Funded Prekindergarten (see right) and/or at least 50% children eligible to receive Child Care Services (CCS) funding**.

- Center-based
- Faith-based
- Community-based

Participating classrooms must have a maintain a minimum number of children, based on age groups:

- Infant classrooms: 4 children
- Toddler classrooms: 6 children
- Preschool classrooms: 6 children (but 10 is preferred)

HOME-BASED CHILD CARE PROVIDERS

All licensed or registered home-based child care programs must be in good standing with Child Care Regulation and have at least 12 months of licensing history.

HEAD START AND EARLY HEAD START PROGRAMS

All children meeting Head Start Requirements are eligible to participate in the project.

SCHOOL DISTRICT/CHARTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

- Open-enrollment Charter School IF partnered with child care or Head Start
- Pre-Kindergarten IF partnered with child care or Head Start

All pre-kindergarten children meeting TEA enrollment requirements are eligible for participation in the project. If Lead Agents provide services to public school classrooms, the classrooms must be partnered with a child care or Head Start program.

COMPONENTS

Eligibility Requirements for State-Funded Prekindergarten

- Be unable to speak and comprehend the English language
- Be educationally disadvantaged (i.e., eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program or Head Start)
- Be homeless
- Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority
- Be the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty
- Have ever been in the conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing.
- Be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as: a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code
