

Interactive Letter Wall

The letter wall is a visual display of the alphabet with a key word picture for each letter. Letter walls should:

- Be at the eye level of the children
- Have two rows (A-M and N-Z)
- Have enough room for the placement of 4-5 words
- Contain words accompanied by a picture for all words



In addition, letter walls should contain a variety of words like:

- Children's names,
- Theme words,
- Read aloud words,
- Words from poems and rhymes
- Everyday words, etc.

All words should begin with a lower case letters except for proper nouns.

In addition, teachers should have a variety of pointers for children to use, such as glasses, flashlight, pointers with theme related characters, etc.
